

Ao1 is committed to doing our part to keep our staff, students, and families safe and healthy this session. As such, Ao1 will be observing current COVID-19 restrictions and implementing the following practices for the fall 2020 session:

- Audition groups will be limited and will be closed to parents and families.
- Students will be required to wear facial masks during auditions removing them only to perform their audition pieces.
- Parents will not be able to wait in the building during auditions.
- We will be holding virtual devotion times this session! Two different day/time options will be offered in hopes that all of our Ao1 students will join us each week! Details will be sent soon!
- All parent meetings will be virtual.
- Students will be checked in and out at the door directly into their classroom. The east lobby doors will remain locked to avoid the gathering of large groups.
- Student temperatures and health screening questions will be completed at check-in.
- Staff temperatures and health screening questions will be completed upon arrival at every Ao1 event.
- All students, staff, and parents are required to wear a face covering to rehearsals/classes/performances.
- Social distancing rules will be observed. This includes the check-in line and parking lot areas.
- Classrooms, restrooms, and common areas will be sanitized between groups.
- Any student exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home and allowed to return only when a negative COVID test has been confirmed.
- Families are required to notify Ao1 if their student has been exposed to COVID-19 or has tested positive.
- Families will be informed if their child is believed to have been exposed to COVID-19.
- Casts/Classes exposed to COVID-19 will close and self-quarantine for 10 days and performances will be rescheduled if necessary.
- There will be **NO** refunds for drops, cancellations, or postponements due to COVID-19.
